ELECTIVES

This degree requires a minimum of 120 hours with a minimum of 42 advanced hours.

Selection into the hospital phase of the MT program is competitive. The number of students accepted by each affiliated hospital is limited and is determined by the national accrediting agency for clinical laboratory sciences. The student is responsible for applying for admission to the hospital. To apply, a student must meet the following requirements:

1. All degree course work, other than MT courses, must either be complete or will be complete by the entry date.
2. A student must have a grade point average of not less than 2.50 overall, not less than 2.50 in required biology courses, and not less than 2.50 in required chemistry courses.
3. The student must request from the Head of the Department of Biology a letter for the hospital stipulating that all requirements have been met.
