Responsibilities include helping students and faculty resolve disputes or questions concerning academic integrity, maintaining confidentiality regarding issues discussed, providing information to the ASU community regarding the Honor Code to reflect recent developments in technology or academic honesty. The committee will strive for equal representation of colleges and schools. The committee will vote by anonymous, written ballot, and the chair of the committee will vote only in the event of a tie. The Executive Director of Student Life and Student Services will serve as a non-voting member, providing necessary advice and ensuring proper procedure is followed. The members will be trained by the Executive Director.
