

**Commemorative Air Force
Wings Over Houston® Airshow
Scholarship Program**



The Commemorative Air Force Wings Over Houston Airshow (WOH) has established a scholarship program for college students who have completed their second year of study in aviation or a related field. The applicant's academic discipline does not have to be in a technical area but may include business, management, marketing or other fields that are directly related to aviation.

For the 2012-2013 academic year, the Wings Over Houston Airshow intends to award up to five scholarships in amounts from \$1,000 to \$5,000 each. The selection will be made by the Wings Over Houston Scholarship Committee in July 2012 and the winner notified by the end of August 2012.

PURPOSE

The WOH scholarships are intended to assist and reward students who have demonstrated academic potential, leadership, and extracurricular involvement.

ELIGIBILITY

Students in good academic standing, and who plan to continue their education by entering the third year (junior year) of any college or university, are eligible for these scholarships subject to the requirements below. Applicants pursuing an academic degree directly associated with aviation, aeronautics, or aerospace will receive priority; the degree of association will be one of the selecting factors.

REQUIREMENTS

1. The applicant must have completed at least two academic years of full-time college work or sixty semester hours of credit at the time of applying for this scholarship.
2. The applicant must have a college grade point average of not less than 3.0 (a B average) on a 4.0 scale.
3. The applicant must be currently enrolled as a full time student in an accredited college, or university, and be planning to enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours (full time) each semester during the year of the awarded scholarship.
4. The applicant's academic course work shall be such as to provide entry into some career field that is associated with aviation or aerospace.
5. Students who receive an award are eligible to reapply in succeeding years. It should be stressed that renewal is not automatic. To apply for a renewal, an individual must complete a new application.
6. Applicants must be either citizens or legal residents of the United States.

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7. The applicant's legal residence must be in Harris County, Texas or one of the contiguous counties surrounding Harris County. These counties are Galveston, Brazoria, Fort Bend, Waller, Montgomery, Liberty, and Chambers¹. A photocopy of a Texas Driver's License or other proof of residence must be included with the application.

A. ADMINISTRATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Administration of the Wings Over Houston Scholarship Program is a sub-committee function of the Wings Over Houston Airshow Board of Directors. The Scholarship Committee consists of at least three members, one of whom serves as the chairperson. He or she is also responsible for maintaining the selection schedule and for making sure that letters and checks are issued to applicants and involved colleges or universities.

The decisions of the Scholarship Committee are considered to be final and the winners for each year will be notified by the end of August. The awards will be publicly announced during the Media Day activities of the Wings Over Houston Airshow.

An application form is included with this letter. Additional applications can be obtained by mail or email upon request or can be downloaded from the WOH website at www.wingsoverhouston.com.

B. SELECTION CRITERIA

The recipients of the scholarship awards will be selected using the following criteria, which are listed in order of importance.

1. **ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE:** This criterion will be evaluated on the basis of each applicant's grade point average or equivalent. A grade point average of at least 3.0 (B) is required.
2. **PERSONAL ASSESSMENT OF CAREER GOALS:** This criterion will be evaluated through a typewritten essay of approximately 1,000 words. The essay should describe the career objectives of the applicant and should outline the academic program required to achieve those career objectives. The essay should also state how the career objectives of the applicant are associated with aviation or aerospace.
3. **RECOMMENDATION:** Each applicant will be judged on personal and academic merit, based on the three required letters of recommendation (see section C. 4.).
4. **EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** Each applicant's participation in college and community activities, organizational offices held, awards, and work experience will receive due consideration.

¹ Residency requirement is waived for members of the Texas A&M University Corps of Cadets. Proof of Corps membership is required in lieu of proof of residence.

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5. **FINANCIAL NEED:** Determination of financial need is primarily based on three factors:
 - a. gross income listed;
 - b. number of family members in the home; and
 - c. number of family members in college.
6. **PERSONAL INTERVIEW:** The Scholarship Committee may request a personal interview if the committee believes that more information or clarification of some items is required.

C. APPLICATION PROCESS

Each applicant is required to provide the following information:

1. A completed application form.
2. A photocopy of the applicant's valid driver's license or other official I.D. showing legal place of residence.
3. A current official college transcript. Photocopies are accepted.
4. Three (3) typewritten letters of recommendation. Past WOH scholarship recipients applying for another scholarship must provide two (2) recommendation letters. Recommendations from relatives of applicants will not be accepted. The letters of recommendation may be attached to the application or sent under separate cover to the address provided below. Recommendation letters must be postmarked no later than June 30th.
5. A typewritten essay of approximately 1,000 words describing the career objectives of the applicant.

The application package, including application form, recommendation letters, transcripts, essay, etc., must be submitted by mail, postmarked no later than **June 30th, 2012**. Completed application packages should be mailed to

D. DISBURSEMENTS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Disbursement shall be made by means of a fund transfer or check from the Wing Over Houston scholarship account to the credit of the recipient at his or her educational institution. Formal award letters will be mailed to the selected recipients and to their educational institutions. Selected scholarship recipients and representatives from their respective educational institutions will be invited to receive the scholarship awards at the Media Day activities of the Wings Over Houston Airshow.
