## **AFIs - Initial and Advanced Programs**

- 1. The unit does not clearly articulate the professional dispositions expected of candidates.
- 2. Limited evidence exists to show that candidates are familiar with or can demonstrate professional dispositions.

# Action already taken:

Spring 2011 – Disposition Committee established and chaired by Dr. Purkiss. Committee begins meeting.

Summer 2011 – Meetings of committee continue. Dispositions finalized. Chart including courses/location for data collection created.

Fall 2011 – Dr. Purkiss spoke to College of Education faculty concerning revised dispositions and locations for data collection. TaskStream Disposition Form created for use in courses. Faculty began TaskStream training if needed. Students asked to buy TaskStream in all courses collecting disposition data.

#### **Action for future:**

Fall 2011 – Faculty begin data collection. More TaskStream training, including report collection for dispositions. Data to be housed in the EPI Center for all programs.

2011-2012 Academic Year – Candidates in undergraduate and graduate programs become familiar with dispositions. Faculty continue data collection and run reports for data analysis.
