

Std. 4 Subcommittee Meeting:

NCATE Standard 4 Committee July 18, 2011

Minutes 2:00 p.m. Sign-in

Present: Richard Evans, Linda Lucksinger

Absent: Jim Summerlin, Karen Cody

An overview of Standard 4 – Diversity was reviewed by members prior to the meeting. Everyone appeared to understand the elements of the standard.

Dr. Lucksinger reviewed the **AFI for Standard 4** – “No system is in place to ensure that field experiences and clinical practice for other school professionals occur in settings with students from diverse groups.” – Advanced Programs only

Dr. Lucksinger stated that information from Curriculum & Instruction programs at the advanced program level and those from Teacher Education (Ed. Diagnostics and Reading Specialist) for the 2010-2011 term needed to be gathered. She will ask Dr. Summerlin to collect the information about programs in C&I; Dr. Evans stated he could provide information for the Ed. Diagnostic program in Teacher Education. Dr. Lucksinger will see if we had any during this term for Reading Specialist (if so may be only 1 or 2 candidates).

New Data gathering for Fall: NCATE standard data and exhibits have changes from prior collection and postings. Updates on data are required and the formats are more direct and structured. Dr. Lucksinger provided a handout Standard 4 with the current information and instructions. The Tables for Exhibits are specific and the EPI Center staff and a graduate assistant have been assisting her in developing the tables (4.3 Exhibits) with data provided by subcommittee members (see below) and EPI Center staff.

By October 12, Committee members roles and responsibilities will be to assist in data collection for Standard 4.1 and 4.2 information as follows:

Dr. Evans – SPED initial & advanced

Dr. Summerlin – C&I data initial & advanced

Dr. Cody – assist with areas outside the C&I or Teacher Ed. programs that may be involved.

Dr. Lucksinger – Teacher Ed data initial and Reading Specialist advanced; draft the narrative and have members proofread it.
