

Equipment Rental: FAQ and Policies

Frequently Asked Questions:

Who is eligible rent equipment?

Any student with a valid Angelo State University ID or a UREC pass member is eligible to rent equipment from the OAC.

Can I make a reservation?

A reservation is the only way to assure we will have the equipment you need. You can reserve equipment up to two weeks in advance by simply [visiting this link](#) and submit your reservation online. The online form may be found in the bottom box of the page.

What happens if I return the equipment late or broken?

Individuals returning equipment late, wet, or in a damaged condition will be assessed an appropriate fine or charged for the item's replacement. Fees for equipment repair, replacement, non-service, and depreciation will be charged for any equipment that is lost, stolen, dirty, or damaged. Warranties supplied by equipment manufacturers do not exempt the user from fines associated with damaging university property.

Do I have to set-up the tent when it is returned?

Yes, this assures that all the pieces of the tent are present and there is no damage.

Do stoves come with fuel?

No, since fuel is a consumable, you will be charged additional per canister. You will receive one canister per stove. This usually enough for a typical weekend trip. If you are renting the equipment for a longer time or plan to do more cooking then normal you can purchase more fuel at the time of rental.

How long is a weekend rental?

A typical weekend rental means picking up your reserved gear on Thursday during normal business hours and returning Monday at least thirty minutes prior to closing.

Can I charge my rentals to my tuition?

No, the OAC only accepts cash, checks, and credit cards.

Do I get a discounted rate for being a student?

Our prices already represent the discounted rate for students.

Policies and Procedures

- There are risks associated with outdoor activities and the renter will not hold Angelo State University, any of its departments or staff, or the State of Texas responsible for injury, accident, or damage incurred while using or transporting this equipment.
- Angelo State University assumes no responsibility for accidents or injuries resulting from the use of rented equipment.
- One person may not rent out gear for an entire group. Each individual may rent equipment for up to two people.
- The renter is responsible for the loss, theft, or damage of all gear, and all gear must be returned clean and dry.
- Renter agrees to examine the damage fees and agrees to pay any damages
- Upon returning equipment, it is the renter's responsibility to finish the equipment return and settle any disputes assessed by OA staff upon return.
- The renter will be charged a flat rate of \$20 per day for late equipment until the equipment is returned. Equipment returns are only accepted as long as they are before thirty minutes to closing.
- All fees due to the Outdoor Adventures Center must be paid within two weeks of the date the renter is notified. The renter's student account will be charged if payment is not made within the two-week window.
- All fees must be paid in the form of cash, check (made payable to: Angelo State University), or credit/debit card. To make a payment stop by CHP Room 112 during normal business hours.
