Angelo State University Undergraduate Research Symposium Instructions and Application

Angelo State University's Annual Undergraduate Research Symposium gives students the opportunity to present research and creative work to the campus community. This all-day event includes venues for presentation in traditional poster and concurrent session formats. Additionally, students presenting creative works may request to present a live performance or static display of artwork.

This is a competitive application process wherein the highest quality projects are selected for presentation. Applicants should therefore carefully review the instructions and selection criteria listed below and prepare their applications accordingly.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Presenters must be undergraduate students currently enrolled at ASU
- Projects must be student-initiated work completed under the mentorship of a faculty member (cannot be student work on a faculty project)
- Students must be available to present their projects on the day of the symposium

Application Instructions:

- 1. Enter each student presenter's full name
- 2. Enter the faculty mentor's name (there may be more than one)
- 3. Enter the title of the project as you want it to appear in the program
- 4. Select the preferred presentation format (poster, oral presentation, performance, or display of artwork). Please note that the selection of a preferred format does *not* guarantee its availability. Due to limitations of time and space, an applicant may be offered the opportunity to present in a different format than requested.
- 5. Enter a brief abstract of the project. Usually, the abstract will include the purpose, methods, analysis, results, and conclusion. The abstract may not exceed 250 words in length, and it should be reviewed by your faculty mentor prior to submission.

Selection Process:

A five-member panel comprised of representatives from each college will review the applications and score them based on the following criteria:

- Originality
- Completeness
- Quality of the work

Applicants and their faculty mentors will receive notification of the panel's decision via e-mail one month prior to the symposium. Those individuals whose projects are selected for presentation will be asked to prepare and submit a 50-word summary of their project for inclusion in the symposium program no later than one week prior to the event.
