EMERGENCY CARE

STUDENTS SHOULD ALWAYS CALL 9-1-1 FOR ALL MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

Students are seen through appointments.

Students arriving at their scheduled appointment time will be seen before walk-ins. Walk-ins will be evaluated by a nurse, who will assess the student's need for an appointment.

HEALTH SERVICES

Students who are registered, attending classes, and have paid the medical services fee have access to unlimited visits to the clinic where they will receive episodic health care (to include examinations, diagnosis and consultation services) provided by **board certified health care providers** at no additional cost.

A medical services fee is automatically assessed to all registered students taking **on-campus** classes, which allows them access to clinic services. *Distance/online learners can access clinic services by paying the current medical services fee for whatever semester they desire services.*

SOME FREE SERVICES OFFERED AT YOUR ASU CLINIC:

- Exams for acute illnesses
- Some over-the-counter medications
- Management of some chronic illnesses
- Follow-up exams
- Wound care
- Crutches loaned out
- Injured limb wraps
- Nebulizer treatments
- Ear lavage
- Blood pressure checks
- Medication refills
- Urinalysis
- Tobacco cessation education and care

SOME MINIMAL FEE SERVICES OFFERED:

- Travel abroad/school physicals
- Vaccines
- Sexually transmitted infections testing
- TB test
- Flu shots
- Maintenance injections
- Strep screen
- Pregnancy test
- Mono screen
- Well women exams

SERVICES FOR THOSE WITH MILITARY IDs

Students with military ID cards may have free services available to them at Goodfellow AFB Clinic. It is important to contact your local TRICARE office to learn about the parameters of your policy plan. Please notify clinic staff if you have a military ID card. The clinic can make referrals to health services offered at GAFB. For military and their dependents, this can save time and money. Contact the TRICARE Service Center at 325-654-3086.

REFERRALS

There are times when a student may need to be referred to the ER, to their primary care provider or to a specialist. These visits will incur fees that the student must bear. *Students must also bear expenses associated with lab work/testing, X-rays, prescription drugs, referrals and other off-campus care.* We encourage students to purchase health insurance to cover these additional costs. Students without insurance may still be given access to lab work after discussing their situation with clinic personnel. **Unpaid lab fees** will be billed to the student's ASU account and initiate a hold until payment is received.

HEALTH INSURANCE

To receive care at Shannon Clinic Urgent Care South students will need to:

1. **Go to the ASU Police Department** at 1702 W. Avenue N (325-942-2071) and be issued a Medical Services Authorization Form by presenting your current and valid ASU OneCard.
2. **Go to Shannon Clinic Urgent Care South and present:**
 - **ASU OneCard**
 - **Medical Services Authorization Form**
 - **Insurance Card** (if insured) ASU will cover your co-pay. If you do not have insurance or if you have a high deductible, the standard visit will be covered.

Standard equivalent care is provided to students. *Additional labs, X-rays, and emergency services will incur charges that the student will be responsible to pay at the time of services given.*
