

Connect to Network Drives from Home (ASU Mac)

Angelo State University allows faculty to connect to various network drives from home using the Cisco AnyConnect client. The steps below will show step by step how to connect to the Angelo network via the Cisco AnyConnect client and access your network drives.



Please Note!

Your activities may be monitored while connected to the Angelo State University network. Any unauthorized activity may result in a loss of network access both from home and on campus!



What You Will Need

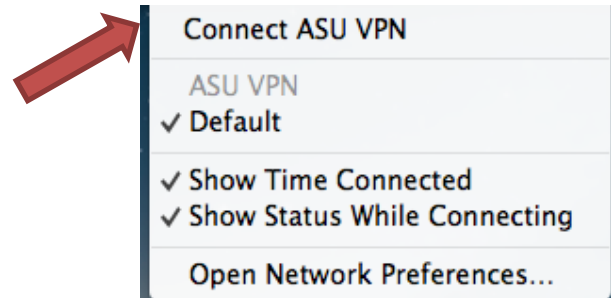
A machine running Mac OS 10.7 or later.

STEP 1: Connect to the VPN client

1. Open the Cisco **VPN client** through the menu bar. The icon looks like this 
2. Click the **Connect ASU VPN**.
3. **Sign into** the login window using your Ramport username and password.
4. Click the **OK** button on the window that pops up.



STEP 2: Access your network drives

When the computer was configured, the network drives should have been added to your favorites list. Once connected to VPN, you should be able to access them from that list.

If you do not see these drives in the favorites list, contact I.T to have them added.



Be aware that the drives will only work if you have access to the network folder and connected to the Angelo network or connected via the Cisco VPN client. If you have any issues connecting, contact the Technology Service Center at (325) 942-2911 or toll free at (866) 942-2911.
