Job Description – Director of Communications and Producer <u>Relations</u>

Under the direction and supervision of the Executive Vice President, the Director of Communications and Producers Relations will coordinate communications for the Board and Association and build/maintain relationships with members, producers and grain elevators. The Director of Communications and Producer Relations will also represent the organization at agricultural field days, producer meetings, farm shows, national meetings and school education programs throughout the year.

Under the Executive Vice President's guidance, the Director of Communications and Producer Relations shall:

- Coordinate and complete communications efforts which may include but are not limited to publishing newsletters; maintaining proactive media relationships; writing news releases and legislative testimony; updating social media channels; arranging for paid advertising; creating presentations, public speaking, coordinating conferences, special events and trade show exhibits.
- Develop and produce education and public relations materials, slide shows, exhibits, displays, videos, radio and television spots featuring the Texas wheat industry for target audiences, specific meeting and conventions.
- Coordinate communications and enhance relationships with grain elevators and producers;
- Complete monthly elevator reporting requirements;
- Maintain membership programs; update producer and associate membership lists and recruit new association members;
- Work with other commodity groups and organizations on events and campaigns pertaining to the agricultural industry;
- Coordinate nutritional messages and activities for the Texas Wheat Producers Board including involvement with the Wheat Foods Council and Home Baking Association;
- Work with the Director of Policy and Marketing to coordinate marketing materials for both organizations;
- Perform other such duties as may be required and assigned by the Executive Vice President of Texas Wheat.
