



Up & Coming Scholars

Established in 1994, the Up & Coming Scholars program allows worthy high school students of good academic ability the chance to plan, prepare for and pursue a college degree.

Selection Process and Criteria

- Students who rank in the top one-third of their class at the end of their freshman (ninth grade) year are invited to apply for the Up & Coming Scholars program during the fall semester of their sophomore year.
- Once selected, students must maintain an academic standing in the top half of their class each year.
- Program participants in good standing are required to meet the admission standards of all students seeking admittance to ASU.
- If program requirements are not met and/ or guidelines not followed, the student will be removed from the program.

Benefits*

- A special ID card granting the same privileges as ASU students, including:

Up & Coming Scholars ID cards must be picked up by Dec. 15 the year students are accepted and before students can have access to any of the listed program benefits.

- Various enrichment activities and informational sessions
- Fee waivers for ASU admission application, New Student Orientation and ACT residual (limited availability)

Program Requirements

If unable to attend due to another school activity, student must notify the program coordinator prior to the event. Non-participation will result in removal from the program.
