\* The student is expected to have completed two years of high school algebra, one-half year of high school trigonometry, and a pre-calculus course. If not, the student will be advised whether Mathematics 1361, 1362 should be completed before enrollment in Mathematics 2331. The student must complete Mathematics 2331 and 2332 prior to the second year of study and must complete Mathematics 3333 and 3335 prior to the third year of study.

Minors – Students may select single or multiple area minors from any of those listed for a Bachelor of Science degree at Angelo State University. Students must complete 18 semester credit hours in a single area minor with six advanced hours in residence. Each discipline in a multiple area minor requires a minimum of nine hours with six advanced hours in residence. The Department of Physics must advise students on minor requirements. The following minor areas for the Physics degree are recommended: Chemistry, Computer Science, Business Administration, Mathematics, and Earth Science.
