

Tom Green County, Texas 2010 Census Proclamation

Whereas, the next Decennial Census will be taken in the year 2010, and political representation to the United States House of Representatives, state legislatures and local governments is determined by the Decennial Census, and Tom Green County recognizes the equal importance of each resident in the 2010 Census count; and,

Whereas, Tom Green County has agreed to be one of 39,000 government entities in partnership with the U.S. Census Bureau; and,

Whereas, Tom Green County understands that its primary role in this partnership is to formulate a COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE; and,

Whereas, the role of the COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE is to bridge the community and the Census Bureau on geographic matters, outreach activities, and information centers; and,

Whereas, the COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE will create census awareness programs for students, coalesce with educational institutions, and distribute Census Bureau Education programs; and,

Whereas, the COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE will cooperate with all print and electronic Media to inform, motivate, and educate the city's residents in the necessity and importance of their rapid response and 100% participation in the 2010 Census; and,

Whereas, the COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE will work across religious denominations to disseminate Census information; and,

Whereas, the COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE will make the community aware of the many ways Census data is used to obtain funding for essential community services and programs; and,

Whereas, the COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE will encourage area businesses to advertise the 2010 Census message and to sponsor 2010 Census community awareness activities; and,


Whereas the COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE will disseminate to all segments of the community, information regarding the availability of Census jobs in the local area;




