

## Instructions - Recommendation for AASN Students Applying to take BSN Courses

This form is designed to ensure that AASN students have fulfilled all requirements to allow them to take one BSN course per semester. Please refer to the requirements and prerequisite section below.

### Students must

- Be in the last year of the AASN program
- Have completed all general academic requirements for the BSN degree
- Have a minimum of 60 college credit hours
- Have a 3.0 grade point average in ASU courses and overall

**BSN courses have specific required prerequisites (see below).**

**Pre-licensure students are required to take following courses in class and may not be taken online.**

- NUR 4403 Research for Nursing Practice: An Evidence-Based Approach
- NUR 3301 Health Policy and Professional Issues
- NUR 3304 Health Assessment

**If an AASN student fails a BSN course, they are not eligible to take other BSN courses until they complete the AASN program.**
