Standards for Admission and Progression LVN-RN Transition Programs

Admission:

- All applicants must be fully admitted to Angelo State University before applying to the LVN-RN Transition Programs. Official transcripts from each college attended must be submitted to the Office of Admissions.
- NOTE: Due to a recent revision to the ASU transfer course policy, all coursework taken elsewhere and transferred into ASU must be a C or better to meet prerequisite requirements. Please see the transfer office if you have any questions about this policy.
- Completed prerequisite courses with a minimum GPA of 2.5:
 - Biology 2411 – Microbiology *OR* Nursing 2411 – Microbiology
 - Biology 2423 – Anatomy
 - Biology 2424 – Physiology
 - English 1301
 - Math 1302 – College Algebra *OR* 1324 – Finite Mathematics I
 - Psychology 1303 – Psychology of Adjustment *OR* 2301 – General Psychology
 - Psychology 2304 – Developmental Psychology
 - NUR 2324 – Pathophysiology

- **TEAS V** exam scores
