



POST MASTER'S CERTIFICATION IN NURSING

Dear Post Master's Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the post master's certificate program. Admission and curriculum information is included in this packet. Classes in the graduate program are offered completely on-line with the exception to one 2-3 day skills lab for the FNP program. Classes are delivered through Blackboard, a course management system. Most online courses are asynchronous, or designed so that students can conveniently complete their work anywhere via internet access. Clinical requirements can be completed in the students' city of residence utilizing a preceptor and a local clinical facility if they meet course objectives.

The nursing post master's certificate program offers three options for study: 1) Nurse Educator Certificate, 2) Clinical Nurse Specialist Completion Certificate, and 3) Family Nurse Practitioner. The application must be submitted to the Department of Nursing office. A separate application and transcripts are required for admission to the Graduate School. All nursing graduate students are required to submit proof of RN licensure.

Procedure for Admission

Admission to the Angelo State University Graduate School:

- Apply to the Graduate School at Angelo State University. The [application](#) is located online and may be submitted electronically.
- Official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended (except Angelo State University) must be provided. To be considered official, the transcript must be mailed from the issuing university's registrar's office directly to the ASU Graduate School.

Admission Requirements

- Completed application and application fee.
- A minimum of a master's degree in nursing accredited by a nationally recognized nursing education accrediting body.
- Current, valid license to practice as a registered nurse in the state(s) in which the student participates in any clinical learning experiences. Proof of current licensure must be demonstrated by the beginning of the fall term in which nursing courses will be taken.
- An application essay of no more than 500 words.
- Preferred Application Deadlines are: **July 1st for Fall** enrollment and **October 1st for Spring** enrollment.

Nurse Educator Post Master's Certificate

The Nurse Educator Completion Certificate is available to nurses that are master's prepared in another subject-area as well as master's or doctorally prepared nurses as a post-master's certificate program.
