GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS REQUESTING TO TRANSFER FROM A NURSING PROGRAM TO THE ANGELO STATE UNIVERSITY GENERIC ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING PROGRAM

Students requesting to transfer to ASU Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree program from another nursing program must submit the following information:

1. A letter requesting to be considered for transfer admission – stating the reasons for this transfer AND a completed application to the AASN program (www.angelo.edu/dept/nursing).
2. Transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.
3. Syllabi of nursing courses completed.
4. Examples/copies of course work.
5. Letter of good standing from the director of the nursing program.
6. Letter of reference from at least one clinical instructor.

Students must meet admission/progression requirements of ASU Nursing Program, including:

- a. Cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above.
- b. Minimum composite Act score of 20 - or a score of 950 on SAT I (taken prior to March 2005) - or a score of 1410 on the SAT I (taken after March 2005).
- c. Grade of "C" or better in Anatomy, Microbiology, Pathophysiology, Physiology.
- d. [TEAS V](#) Nursing Entrance Exam.

Students must meet admission requirements of ASU Admissions Office.

Students must complete 30 hours in residence to meet ASU graduation requirements.

A Nursing Program committee will review material submitted and make recommendations.
