Recommendation for AASN Students Applying to take BSN Courses

This form is designed to ensure that AASN students have fulfilled all requirements to allow them to take **one** BSN course per semester. Please refer to the requirements and prerequisite section below.

Students must

- Be in the last year of the AASN program
- Have completed all general academic requirements for the BSN degree
- Have a minimum of 60 college credit hours
- Have a 3.0 grade point average in ASU courses and overall
- Take only ONE BSN course per semester while in the AASN program

In addition to any BSN course prerequisites, AASN students have specific required prerequisites to take RN to BSN courses (see below).

If an AASN student fails a BSN course, they are not eligible to take other BSN courses until they complete the AASN program.
