## New Students: Fall 2009

February 1, 2009	Apply On-line open for academic year 2009—2010.
May 21, 2009	<b>Payment deadline for the \$50.00 application fee and \$150.00 deposit (\$200.00 total) to be included in the first room assignment lottery. (Lottery #1)</b> (Note: You must have applied on -line AND be accepted to the university by this date to be included in this lottery)
May 25—31, 2009	<b>Roommate selection lottery for assignment lottery #1.</b> (If you are eligible for assignment lottery #1, this is when you will log in to MyHousing and enter your roommate request info if you have a specific person(s) you want to live with. Your requested roommate(s) must also be eligible/ included in this lottery.)
June 3, 2009:	<b>New student Room and Roommate auto-assignment lottery #1.</b> Check your MyHousing after June 3rd to view your assignment and roommate information. (Note: This information may change as a result of cancellations etc. Please check frequently for updates.)
June 8, 2009	<b>Payment deadline for the \$50.00 application fee and \$150.00 deposit (\$200.00 total) to be included in the second room assignment lottery. (Lottery #2)</b> (Note: You must have applied on line AND be accepted to the university by this date to be included in this lottery)
June 10—12, 2009	<b>Roommate selection lottery for assignment lottery #2.</b> (If you are eligible for assignment lottery #2, this is when you will log in to MyHousing and enter your roommate request info if you have a specific person(s) you want to live with. Your requested roommate(s) must also be eligible/ included in this lottery.)
June 17, 2009:	<b>New student Room and Roommate auto-assignment process #2.</b> Check your MyHousing after June 17rd to view your assignment and roommate information. (Note: This information may change as a result of cancellations etc. Please check frequently for updates.)

July 6, 2009

**Payment deadline for the \$50.00 application fee and \$150.00 deposit (\$200.00 total) to be included in the third room assignment lottery. (Lottery #3)** (Note: You must have applied on line AND be accepted to the university by this date to be included in this lottery)

July 8—10, 2009

**Roommate selection lottery for assignment lottery #3.** (If you are eligible for assignment lottery #3, this is when you will log in to MyHousing and enter your roommate request info if you have a specific person(s) you want to live with. Your requested roommate(s) must also be eligible/ included in this lottery.)

July 15, 2009:

**New student Room and Roommate auto-assignment lottery #3.** Check your MyHousing after July 15th to view your assignment and roommate information. (Note: This information may change as a result of cancellations etc. Please check frequently for updates.)

July 20, 2009

**Payment deadline for the \$50.00 application fee and \$150.00 deposit (\$200.00 total) to be included in the fourth room assignment lottery. (Lottery #4)** (Note: You must have applied on line AND be accepted to the university by this date to be included in this lottery)

July 22—24, 2009

**Roommate selection lottery for assignment lottery #4.** (If you are eligible for assignment lottery #4, this is when you will log in to MyHousing and enter your roommate request info if you have a specific person(s) you want to live with. Your requested roommate(s) must also be eligible/ included in this lottery.)

July 29, 2009:
