

ASU's Maxwell is new President of Texas Society of Mammalogists

Students and faculty from ASU just completed a highly successful 2009 meeting of the Texas Society of Mammalogists (TSM). 10 students and 4 faculty from ASU participated with one poster presented and 3 oral presentations by students – two of whom won awards.

Dana Lee won the TSM Award for the *Best Oral Presentation* in Systematics for her talk "Taxonomic status of the Davis Mountains Cottontail, *Sylvilagus robustus* (Lagomorpha: Leporidae) revealed by amplified fragment length polymorphism". Wes Brashear won the *Rollin Baker Award* for best undergraduate presentation with "Home Range and Den Site Analysis of the American Hog-nosed Skunk, *Conepatus leuconotus*".

ASU Professor Terry Maxwell was elected the next President of the society.
