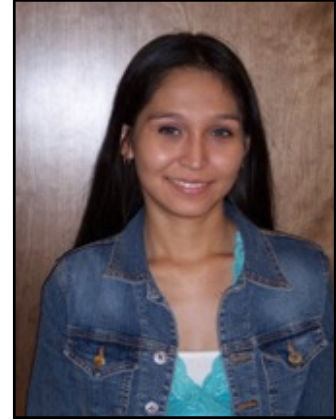

# Spotlight on SI Leaders



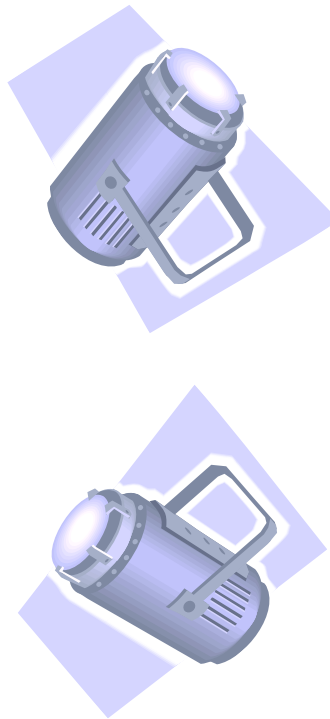
**Mark Lussier**
