- Apply for admission to Angelo State University at www.angelo.edu/dept/admissions
- Visit the ASU Office of Financial Aid Web site at www.angelo.edu/services/financial_aid to learn about grants, loans and scholarships available.
- Contact the Student Accounts/Bursar's Office toll free at 1-877-942-2008 or billing@angelo.edu to get information about state VA education programs.
- Visit the campus Veterans Affairs Office in Room 101M of the Hardeman Building for federal VA benefits information.
 - Fill out your VA Enrollment Form.

 - Fill out your VA Application/Transfer Form.
 - Bring required paperwork.
- Make arrangements for school enrollment. Make sure that you:
 - Meet with a department adviser. For more information, contact the academic department in which you plan to major. If you are undeclared, contact the Center for Academic Excellence at (325) 942-2710 or advisers@angelo.edu.
 - Register for classes. You can register online through RAMS (<http://www.angelo.edu/rams/>) or in the Registrar's Office in Room 200 of the Hardeman Building.
 - Make any payment arrangements on RamPort (<http://ramport.angelo.edu>). You can elect to pay in installments or all at once. Then, you will have the option of paying by mail, in person or online.
 - Request an ASU OneCard. The OneCard is the official ASU identification card. You are required to have a OneCard to access services, events and facilities at ASU. For more information, call (325) 942-2331 or visit the OneCard Web site at <http://www.angelo.edu/services/asuone/>.
 - Obtain a parking permit. For more information, call the Parking Services Office at (325) 942-2071 or visit the department office in the West Annex at 1825 W. Johnson St.
 - Buy your textbooks. Visit the ASU Bookstore in the University Center.
