From College Station: (300 miles)

Take Highway 6 North for 10 miles

Take 190 West to I-35 (80 miles)

Temple

Take I-35 N to 190 (5 miles)

Take 190 W to 183 (50 miles)

Lampasas

Take 183 to 190 (20 miles)

Lometa

Take 190 to 283 (60 miles)

Take 283 to 87 (5 miles)

Brady

Take 87 to 306 Loop (70 miles)

Take 306 Loop to Knickerbocker Exit and turn right on Knickerbocker, if you hit College Hills exit you've gone too far.

Drive through ~5 lights (about 1.5 miles). There will be a Taco Bell on your right.

Take a left on Jackson Avenue. At the stop sign, continue on Jackson. The fields will be a little further on your right.

From Houston: (400 miles)

Take I-10 to Junction (310 miles)

Take 83 N to 87 (50 miles)

Eden

Pick up 87 and take it into 306 loop (40 miles)

Take 306 Loop to Knickerbocker Exit and turn right on Knickerbocker, if you hit College Hills exit you've gone too far.

Drive through ~5 lights (about 1.5 miles) There will be a Taco Bell on your right.

Take a left on Jackson Avenue. At the stop sign, continue on Jackson. The fields will be a little further on your right.

From San Antonio (200 miles)

Take I-10 to Junction (110 miles)

Take 83 N to 87 (50 miles)

Eden

Pick up 87 and take it into 306 loop (40 miles)

Take 306 Loop to Knickerbocker Exit and turn right on Knickerbocker, if you hit College Hills exit you've gone too far.

Drive through ~5 lights (about 1.5 miles) There will be a Taco Bell on your right.

Take a left on Jackson Avenue. At the stop sign, continue on Jackson. The fields will be a little further on your right.

From Lubbock: (200 miles)

Take 87S to San Angelo (~190 miles)

{In San Angelo itself, 87 is Bryant Ave and at times Abe Avenue}

You will come to a large overpass called the Houston Harte Expressway (Highway 67). The feeders along this highway are labeled 7th and 6th street. Continue on Bryant/Highway 87.

Including the light at 7th street you will drive through 7 lights (about 1.9 miles) on Bryant Avenue.

You will come to Avenue N, Kentucky Fried Chicken is at the intersection of Avenue N and Bryant. IF you hit Knickerbocker on Bryant you have gone too far. Take a right on Avenue N and go through 1 more light (about 1 mile).

Drive through 3 lights (about 1.0 miles).
Drive through ~5 lights (about 1.5 miles) There will be a Taco Bell on your right.
Take a left on Jackson Avenue. At the stop sign, continue on Jackson. The fields will be a little further on your right.

Huntsville, TX (350 miles)
Take I-45 N to SR-164 (65 miles)
Exit onto SR-164 and head towards Waco (55 miles)
In Waco, Take SR-6 for 9 miles until you hit Business-77
Take Business-77 2 miles until you hit 84 W (You may want to allow for more time in Waco; if you get lost, get onto I-35 and find the exit for 84 W)
Take 84 W to Goldthwaite (70 miles)
