DESCRIPTION

The Biology Department at Angelo State University has a vacancy in a tenure-track faculty position for a person with expertise in developmental biology using a molecular approach. The candidate will be expected to teach Developmental Biology and other service courses including Introductory Biology. There may be opportunity to teach other upper division courses in an area of expertise. A teaching load of 12 weighted contact hours per semester is expected. The candidate will also participate in advising undergraduate students, especially pre-health professions students. Supervision of undergraduate and graduate research and participation in departmental and University service are also expected.
