<b>Instrument</b>	<b>rotation</b>	<b>Who is involved</b>
Admin	Rotation is under review. It was annual but will be less often in the future.	all appropriate staff/faculty evaluate
Alum	Surveying is on-going via the Web.	interested alumni participate
Grad	Surveying is on-going via the graduation application.	those completing a graduation application
IDEA	Various courses are evaluated each long semester. Faculty can opt to evaluate in summer.	all course-enrolled students evaluate
MAPP	Rotation is every third fall. First-year students are evaluated again three years later.	random samples are tested
MFT	MFTs are administered on-going as department need dictates.	all applicable majors are tested
NSSE	Rotation is every other spring online.	random samples of freshmen/seniors evaluate
SOS	Rotation is every third spring administered in classes.	random classes evaluate
