



Brisket Cook-Off Rules

1. Each team participating must check-in with a Homecoming staff member at the registration table. You will be given a number and a plate to provide your brisket for judging.
2. All brisket entries will be cooked on location. Brisket must arrive at the event completely raw. If brisket is pre-heated, or pre-cooked, the brisket entry will be disqualified and no points will be awarded.
3. Student Organizations will be allowed to marinate brisket **using their own recipe** prior to the event. (Store bought brisket that is pre-marinated is prohibited.)
4. No alcoholic beverages are allowed. Student organizations and/or teams caught with alcoholic beverages will be asked to leave by the University Police and will forfeit all points for the brisket cook-off contest. This includes alcoholic beverages in recipes.
5. Only ASU students, faculty, and staff may participate in the contest.
6. Music will be provided during this event.
7. All entries will be judged anonymously.
8. Cooking will begin at **9:30 a.m.** and must be completed no later than **5:00 p.m.** on Sunday, October 9th.
