



## 2011 Nomination Rules

1. Nominations for queen must be of the female gender.
2. Nominations for king must be of the male gender.
3. Must be enrolled in at least 12 semester hours.
4. Must have a 2.00 cumulative GPA or higher.
5. All student organizations must submit nominees online.
6. Registered student organizations are eligible to nominate one (1) king and one (1) queen candidate.
7. ASU Mascots (Roscoe and Bella) are ineligible to be nominated for King or Queen.
8. **CANDIDATES MUST BE NOMINATED BY A REGISTERED STUDENT ORGANIZATION.** Student organizations must be renewed for the Fall Semester prior to submitting a nominee. Student Organization Registration forms can be picked up in the Center for Student Involvement.
9. All pictures will be taken by Danny Meyer, University Photographer. Please call the Center for Student Involvement at 942-2062 to schedule an appointment.
10. It is the responsibility of each organization to make sure that their candidate is eligible under the guidelines established by the ASU Homecoming Committee. To insure candidate eligibility before deadline, submit applications as soon as possible.
11. Nominees must agree to participate in all Homecoming Activities assigned (including Nominee Presentation Rehearsal, October 7th at 4:00 p.m. and Nominee Presentation on Monday, October 10<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m.).
12. The Homecoming Committee will handle all publicity. No individual campaign posters or signs are permitted.
13. Members of the Homecoming Committee are ineligible to be nominated for King or Queen.
14. Nominees must follow all campaign rules and guidelines.
15. An escort is not required if your nominating organization is nominating a King or Queen candidate. He or she will be your escort.
16. All nominees must be submitted online by **Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>**.
