

Project Spring Break Application



The Center for Student Involvement is seeking participant applications for Project Spring Break 2010. The trip will consist of student volunteers in addition to 2 staff members from Angelo State University.

Applicants must meet the following requirements

- *Cumulative GPA of 2.3 or higher
- *Must be a full-time student enrolled in a minimum of 12 hours
- *Must have involvement/experience in community service
- *If selected, you must attend a mandatory meeting prior to the trip

Trip Information

- We will leave on Sunday, March 14th and return Friday, March 19th.
- The trip will take place in New Orleans, LA where students will volunteer with HandsOn New Orleans to help restructure communities devastated by Hurricane Katrina. This trip will also include a day of sightseeing in New Orleans, LA.
- **Participant fee is \$25.00.** The trip is being funded by the Center for Student Involvement and Student Life. This includes all program costs, accommodations for five nights, transportation to and from New Orleans, 3 meals per day, and 2 t-shirts.
- We will stay in HandsOn New Orleans' Volunteer House. The facility is a communal living environment, so bathrooms, showers, and dining areas are shared. As part of the community, volunteers are asked to sign up for house duties to help maintain the facility during our stay. This can include morning clean-up, cooking for other volunteers, or dinner kitchen patrol.
- Volunteers will participate in regular community meetings at the Volunteer House. Community meetings occur during dinner and are a place for volunteers to share their experiences and hear about all the good work going on in the city.
- Volunteers are required to work approximately 6-8 hours each day on the project site.
- Please remember to act responsibly, respectfully and professionally in all places, with all people, at all times – you are representing Angelo State University.
