SPONSOR: The Brownwood Art Association is seeking applicants for a new \$1000 scholarship from university and college visual arts majors.

ELIGIBILITY: The scholarship is available to students who will be second semester sophomores or first semester junior visual arts majors next semester (spring semester 2012). Applicants must be attending a university or college within a one hundred-mile radius of Brown County (Abilene Christian University, Angelo State University, Cisco Junior College, Hardin-Simmons University, Howard Payne University, McMurry University and Tarleton State University). Applicants must be full-time students majoring in studio art or art education and planning to enroll full-time next year. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (all college classes) or higher.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND DISBURSEMENT: The \$1,000 scholarship payment will be made directly to the winning student's university or college for tuition, books, fees or art supplies. This scholarship will only be available for the spring semester of 2012.

SPECIFICATIONS: Three entries of which were completed within the last year must be submitted for this judging. Artwork may be two-dimensional or three-dimensional. Please submit images of these artworks in JPG format at a maximum size of 700 pixels on the longest side and at (72 dpi) to info@brownwoodart.com with a subject title of "BAA Scholarship Competition." Each applicant must include an artist's statement. The statement should include your reasons for wanting to be an artist, major influences or work that you admire, and academic and artistic goals.
