Fill out the Summer Supplemental Application (SSAP)

- April 1
- Secure approval for admission or readmission to the University as a regular student including the evaluation of any transfer hours from the Undergraduate or Graduate Admissions Office.
- A student and parent (if applicable) PIN is required in order to electronically sign and submit the FAFSA – renewal applicants and parents do not need to apply for another PIN.
- Submit the FAFSA to apply for federal and state grants, loans, work, and need-based scholarship programs – include ASU's Federal School Code (003541) in the school section to ensure electronic access to the information by the Financial Aid Office.
- Submit the Disclosure of Additional Resources Form if you expect to receive any assistance from sources other than the Financial Aid Office – e.g., outside agency scholarships. Failure to submit this information may cause you to repay aid.
- Additional documents may be required if you are selected for the process of verification or to clarify your individual circumstance. You will be notified if additional documents are required.
- Meet and maintain the requirements outlined in the Statement of Satisfactory Academic Progress.
- A student interested in applying for financial aid for the summer will need to submit the Summer Supplemental Application (available online in November) by March 1.
