**State of Texas = \$1000**

- **Eligibility**

- Declare a major before registering
- Follow degree plan requirements
- Meet with your Academic Advisor each semester
- Enroll in 8 consecutive long semesters over a 4 year period
- Maintain GPA for your major (2.5 GPA)
- Apply for graduation before the deadline
- Contact the Registrar's Office for questions

# Advising

- Complete a Graduation Plan (4 year plan)
  - course rotations, pre-requisites, projected graduation date
- Graduate on time
  - Follow degree plan
- Transfer credits
- GPA requirements
  - 2.5 GPA
  - “C” or better on coursework, excluding electives
- Student services on campus



# Individual Advising

- Must make an appointment
- Create a personalized long term plan
- Questions about your transfer credits
- GPA requirements
- Questions about your Degree Evaluation
- Student services on campus
- Students not admitted to the EPP contact  
Mrs. Word
- Students admitted to the EPP contact your  
faculty advisor
- **Academic Probation students are required  
to meet with Mrs. Word**



# Spring Registration

Registration begins by classification :

- November 8<sup>th</sup>- Seniors
- November 10<sup>th</sup> - Juniors
- November 15<sup>th</sup> - Sophomores
- November 17<sup>th</sup> – Freshmen
- November 22<sup>nd</sup> - All students



# Official Degree Plan

- Effective Fall 2010 – all students must declare a major by 30 semester credit hours
- To declare a major file an official degree plan:
  - in Mrs. Word's office in the EPI Center (Carr 287)
  - in Teacher Education Office Carr 145

# Student Teaching Requirements

- **2.50 GPA:**
  - Overall
  - Major Coursework- “C” or better
  - Professional Ed Coursework- “C” or better



# Student Teaching Requirements

- Completed all required advanced pedagogy courses (within grade requirement)
- INDS majors must have completed all courses (with grade requirement)
- For additional requirements, check the applicable Angelo State University Undergraduate Catalogue

# How to Apply to Student Teach

- You must attend a Mandatory Student Teaching Application Meeting during the long semester BEFORE you student teach to receive application instructions.



# Remote Student Teaching Placement Policy

ASU policy is that anyone who will be student teaching in a district more than 50 miles from San Angelo will be charged a remote student teaching fee of \$600.

# Advising

- **Turn in your advising form**

  - Advising hold prevents registration
- **Check your Student Records in RamPort for other holds**
