

GPA Calculation

For admission into the graduate program for certification and to ensure highly qualified status, undergraduate course work is reviewed. Overall GPA, or the last 60 semester credit hours GPA, as well as the content area GPA are analyzed. The content area GPA is used to determine eligibility for the appropriate Pre-Admission Content Test (PACT). All undergraduate transcript(s) must be submitted for an accurate and complete evaluation. The evaluation consists of verifying the person has completed a Bachelor degree from an accredited institution as well as calculating the overall undergraduate GPA and the specified content area GPA to ensure both meet the state required 2.5 minimums. For additional consideration, the last 60 SCH GPA is also calculated. In accordance with state and University standards, the evaluation verifies that the person completed a minimum of 12 semester credit hours (SCH) in lower and advanced levels of coursework for a total of 24 semester credit hours in the specified content area.
