Reference: Campus Post Office Thefts



The United States Postal Inspection Office, along with members of the University Police Department, have been investigating several complaints received regarding missing mail at the ASU post office. The thefts apparently began sometime in Fall 2009.

On April 30, 2010, postal inspectors identified a suspect. This suspect was detained and found to be in possession of stolen mail from the campus post office. In June 2010, the suspect was indicted on federal mail theft charges and is awaiting trial.
