

SUBJECT: University Police Issue Campus Area Advisory

On this date, San Angelo Police notified University Police regarding an incident that occurred off campus. Given the circumstances and proximity to the campus, the University Police Department, in cooperation with San Angelo Police, are releasing the following campus advisory:

On Tuesday, January 5th at about 2:30PM, a female reported she was driving in the 2000 blk of W. Ave N. The female stopped her vehicle when she spilled a coke in her lap. While cleaning up the spill, the female reported she was approached by two Hispanic males, one looked to be in his 40's and the other in his 20's.

The female said the male subjects told her they had some flooring products in their pickup and asked if she wanted to see them. She described the pickup as an 80's model four door pickup with a black grill guard. The female was unable to provide police with a license plate number.

The female said the male subjects were very adamant about her looking at the flooring. The female said she was not interested and started to pull away. While preparing to drive off, the older male attempted to grab the door to her vehicle.

The female reported she was not harmed during the incident. It is unknown what the intentions of the subjects were. The female declined to file an official police report but did request the incident be documented.

While the incident occurred off campus, Police recommend individuals in this area exercise due caution. Any suspicious activity should be immediately reported to the San Angelo Police Department or University Police at 942-2071.
