Second Robbery Reported Close to Campus

A second robbery in two weeks has been reported close to the campus. The first robbery occurred on Sunday, November 26 at the Happy Shack, 1807 S. Lincoln.

The second robbery occurred at approximately 9:15PM on Wednesday, December 6th at the Skinny's Convenient Store, 1801 S. Pierce.

According to police reports, an Hispanic male robbed a female customer as she exited the store for her vehicle. The suspect brandished a knife during the commission of the robbery. The male was said to be wearing a blue bandana over his face and cotton type gloves. He was also believed to have been wearing a blue/red jacket with a hoodie. No other physical description was available. The victim was not injured in the incident.

It can be assumed that conditions continue to exist that may pose a direct threat to members and guest of the campus community.
