### Chart of Fees for Select Research Services

An approved and signed Experimental Protocols Form found in the *FSPD Procedures and Protocols Manual* must accompany all experimental trials before services can be completed.

<b>Harvest</b> <sup>1</sup>	Lamb <sup>a</sup> (up to 160lb LW)	\$35.00/hd
	Goat <sup>b</sup> (up to 150lb LW)	\$30.00/hd
	Swine <sup>c</sup> (up to 280lb LW)	\$35.00/hd
	Cattle <sup>d</sup> (up to 1200lb LW)	\$65.00/hd

<sup>1</sup> Harvesting process includes lairage 1 day prior to scheduled harvest and 1 week carcass storage after harvesting. All harvesting processed are conducted according to USDA-FSIS guidelines

<sup>a,b</sup> Price denoted is valid for live weights up to 160lb – additional fees will apply for live weights over 160lbs – maximum weight ~ 200lb

<sup>c</sup> Price denoted is valid for live weights up to 280lb – additional fees will apply for live weights over 280lbs – maximum weight ~ 320lb

<sup>d</sup> Price denoted is valid for live weights up to 1200lb – additional fees will apply for live weights over 1200lbs – maximum weight ~ 1500lb

<b>Processing</b> <sup>2</sup>	Lamb <sup>e</sup>	\$0.75/lb
	Goat <sup>e</sup>	\$0.75/lb
	Swine <sup>e</sup>	\$0.75/lb
	Cattle <sup>e</sup>	\$0.75/lb

<sup>2</sup> Processing includes fabrication, labeling and packaging – prior arrangements must be made for special processing and fabrication needs – all product is vacuum packaged – product for further analysis should be denoted on experimental protocol form

<sup>e</sup> Processing fee assessed on a HCW (hot carcass weight) basis

<b>Storage</b>	Carcass <sup>f</sup>	\$2.50/week
