The Hearing Panel will conduct disciplinary Panel Hearings. The Panel pool will consist of a trained pool of full-time faculty, full-time staff, and full-time students. The Dean of Students or the Director of Student Transitions and Title IX Compliance will be responsible for assembling and training the hearing panel annually.

The Hearing Panel will consist of full-time faculty members, full-time staff members, and full-time students. This pool will be made up of three (3) full-time faculty and staff members from each division on campus along with three (3) full- time students and a pool of Administrative Hearing Officers.

The Title IX and Sexual Misconduct Response Team consists of faculty and staff who have been recommended to the Office of Title IX Compliance by their Vice President or the President to serve on the team. Members of the team may serve as Investigators or Hearing Panel Members in cases related to Title IX or sexual misconduct.

## Hearing Panel Composition:

For each Hearing, a Hearing Panel will consist of three (3) members chosen from the available pool by the Dean of Students, Director of Student Transitions and Title IX Compliance, or designee. For a hearing involving charges of sexual misconduct or Title IX violations, the Director of Student Transitions and Title IX Compliance will appoint three (3) members of the Title IX and Sexual Misconduct Response Team who did not serve as an investigator in the case. For all other student conduct hearings, the Dean of Students or designee will appoint three (3) members chosen from the available pool. Typically, a non-sexual misconduct or Title IX Hearing Panel will be comprised of one student, one faculty member, and one staff member. The Hearing Panel composition may include only professional faculty and/or staff members in cases involving sensitive issue. Availability may determine a different composition for the Panel.

a) The President of the Student Government Association is invited to make recommendations for full-time student Panel members. Upon recommendation and review, three (3) full time student members will be appointed by the Dean of Students or designee. To be eligible for appointment, students must be considered full-time students, be in good academic and disciplinary standing, and have completed at least 15 hours of academic credit with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0.
b) The Vice President of each division (Student Affairs, Academic Affairs, Finance and Administration, and External Affairs) and the President are invited to make recommendations for full-time faculty and/or staff for the Hearing Panel members and members of the Title IX and Sexual Misconduct Response Team. Upon recommendation and review, three (3) full-time faculty and/or full-time staff members from each division will be appointed by the Dean of Students, Director of Student Transitions and Title IX Compliance or designee.

The Director of Student Transitions and Title IX Compliance or the Dean of Students or designee may appoint additional members to the Hearing Panel to expedite the orderly disposition of cases and/or to aid in the administration of the conduct process within the University. The additional members of the Hearing Panel will complete the same training, have the same composition of membership, the same duties, and the same authority as the original Hearing Panel member(s).

Each member will be appointed for a single one-year term. Panel members may be reappointed for consecutive one-year terms but must complete the Hearing Panel training annually.

The Dean of Students, Director of Student Transitions and Title IX Compliance or designee will appoint a Resource Person. The Resource Person is to serve as a non-voting member of the Hearing Panel and assures that University procedures are followed throughout each Panel hearing. The Resource Person is responsible for composing the Panel's decision, rationale, and appropriate sanctions.

The primary function of the University Curriculum Committee is to make recommendations to the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs on the curriculum and academic programs of the university, ensuring that institutional policies are followed, including but not limited to ASU OP 04.01: Councils and Committees, ASU OP 04.05: Approval Process for New Degree Programs, ASU OP 02.06: Reporting Substantive Change to SACSCOC, ASU OP 04.11: Distance Education, and ASU OP 04.12: Definition and Calculation of Credit Hours. The committee ensures the review of changes to university curriculum, programs, and courses, including for the determination of amount and level of credit awarded. The University Curriculum Committee is not charged with executive or administrative responsibilities.

Two faculty members are recommended from each of the five undergraduate colleges by the Faculty Senate through the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs. Appointed by the President upon recommendation from the Faculty Senate to the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Standing membership for administrative positions. Three-year staggered terms for faculty appointments. *One-year term for non-tenured faculty members. Chair to serve one year unless reappointed.

The Chair is elected from among the full-time faculty committee members at the first meeting in the fall.
