The most common mistake made is clicking the submit button too soon. | <p>Question #2</p> | <p>Admission Status - To qualify for any scholarship from this application I understand that I must be admitted to Angelo State University as a degree seeking student.</p> <p>Enrollment Requirements - The scholarships on this application require full-time enrollment: Undergraduate 12+ hours, Graduate 9+ hours.</p> <p>Financial Need - Some of the scholarships you are applying for through this application may require financial need as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).</p> <p>Incomplete applications - Failure to answer all questions on this application will prevent my application from being sent to the scholarship committee for review.</p> <p>I understand that the scholarships I am applying for are not renewable and I must complete the ASU General scholarship application each year to apply.</p> | <p>We provide this information on the scholarship application for informational purposes. This is so you understand that the application is intended for degree seeking, full-time students.</p> <p>This question is on all ASU scholarship applications.</p> |

| <p>Question #4</p> | <p>State law requires that each student identify any relation to a current member of the Texas Tech University (TTU) System Board of Regents. A student who is related to a current member of the TTU System Board of Regents is prohibited from receiving any scholarship unless the scholarship is awarded based on academics or is an athletic scholarship.</p> <p>It is a class B misdemeanor to file a false statement.</p> <p>https://www.texastech.edu/board-of-regents/</p> | <p>This question is required by state law, and you must indicate if you are related to a current Texas Tech Board of Regent member.</p> <p>This question is on all ASU scholarship applications.</p> |

You must provide a response or type "not applicable" or your application will be marked incomplete and not sent to the committee for review.</p> | <p>We need you to provide us with your major so that we can ensure that your specific major meets our donor criteria.</p> <p>This question is on all ASU scholarship applications.</p> |

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| <p>Question #6</p> | <p>Tell the scholarship committee why you chose your major. If you have not decided on a major explain to the committee about your interests.</p> <p>You have 2000 characters worth of space below. We recommend you proof read your answer for grammar and spelling mistakes before submitting your application.</p> <p>Do not leave the comment section blank.</p> <p>You must provide a response or type "not applicable" or your application will be marked incomplete and not sent to the committee for review.</p> | <p>Explain how your major lines up with your career goals.</p> <p>Provide the committee with information showing how much thought you have put into choosing your major.</p> <p>If you have not selected a major, provide the committee with information about you and your interests.</p> <p>Helpful Hint!! | <p>Question #7</p> | <p>On a 4.0 scale, what is your grade point average (GPA)?</p> <p>New freshmen students that have not completed a semester at ASU should enter their high school GPA.</p> <p>New transfer students should enter their transfer GPA.</p> <p>New graduate students should enter their undergraduate GPA.</p> <p>Current ASU students should enter their ASU GPA.</p> <p>Do not leave the comment section blank.</p> <p>You must provide a response or type "not applicable" or your application will be marked incomplete and not sent to the committee for review.</p> | <p>Your answer from this question will be provided to the scholarship committee, be sure you enter your GPA as accurately as possible.</p> <p>This question is on all ASU scholarship applications.</p> |

We recommend that you proofread your answers for grammar and spelling mistakes before submitting your application.</p> <p>Do not leave the comment section blank.</p> <p>You must provide a response or type "not applicable" or your application will be marked incomplete and not sent to the committee for review.</p> | <p>For some of you, you already know exactly where you see yourself in 5 years, where others of you don't really know what you will be doing in 1 year, much less 5 years.</p> <p>Be honest about yourself and what you hope to have accomplished in 5 years.</p> <p>Be specific. If you will be a business owner, do not simply say "In 5 years I will own my own business and live in New York". | <p>Question #12</p> | <p>Volunteerism - Please list the organizations you volunteered with over the last two years. Also, indicate if you volunteered with programs/organizations through ASU or outside of ASU. Spell out the name of each organization and provide the years you participated. Do not use acronyms or initials.</p> <p>Do not leave the comment section blank.</p> <p>You must provide a response or type "not applicable" or your application will be marked incomplete and not sent to the committee for review.</p> | <p>This is where you can provide the committee with how you are active in volunteering. You can list volunteerism you have participated in at school, church, work or other areas.</p> <p>Helpful Hint!! Copy your answer to this question into a Word Document, and reuse it for other ASU scholarship applications.</p> |
| <p>Question #13</p> | <p>Roles of Leadership - This is where you will be able to provide the committee with information about roles of leadership you have held in the last two years. Please indicate if the leadership positions are at ASU, high school or not related to school.</p> <p>Spell out the name of each organization and position held; do not use acronyms or initials. You only have 2000 characters so you may want to type your roles of leadership in a Word document and count the characters. Please keep in mind that bullet points do not transfer when you copy and paste.</p> <p>Do not leave the comment section blank.</p> <p>You must provide a response or type "not applicable" or your application will be marked incomplete and not sent to the committee for review.</p> | <p>Have you held positions of leadership, in school, athletics, work or other areas? This could include loss of employment due to workforce reductions or family medical expenses.</p> <p>You have 2000 characters worth of space below. We recommend that you proofread your answers for grammar and spelling mistakes before submitting your application.</p> <p>Do not leave the comment section blank.</p> <p>You must provide a response or type "not applicable" or your application will be marked incomplete and not sent to the committee for review.</p> | <p>This question is where you can provide information to the scholarship committee about events, beyond your control have impacted your and your family's ability to afford your cost of college.</p> <p>Examples are to include but not limited to:</p> <p>Loss of income of you or a family member due to workforce reductions</p> <p>Medical expenses for you or your family members</p> <p>Please keep in mind that the committee members already know that going to college is expensive, use this question to only explain situations that have impacted your or your family's ability to pay for college that were beyond your control.</p> <p>Helpful Hint!! | <p>Question #15</p> | <p>Please provide the committee with your City, State and County and Country of your hometown.</p> <p>Please type your response as follows: City, State, County, Country. If you do not have County or State associated with your hometown please type your response as follows: City, N/A, N/A, Country.</p> <p>Do not leave the comment section blank.</p> <p>You must provide a response or type "not applicable" or your application will be marked incomplete and not sent to the committee for review.</p> | <p>Many of ASU donor's have specified their scholarship go to students from a specific town, high school or county. Where other donor's want to know where you are from, please do not leave this question blank.</p> <p>This question is on all ASU scholarship applications.</p> |
