2. Be admitted to the ASU College of Graduate Studies.
3. Have the appropriate undergraduate grade point average.
4. Have a signed degree or certification plan on file.
5. Have read and signed the G-EPP Disposition Statement and the Educator Code of Ethics.
6. If coming from another educator preparation program, completed the TEA Data Reassignment Form.

If a probationary certificate is sought, a candidate must:

- 1. Be admitted to the G-EPP.
2. Obtain a signed Statement of Eligibility for Internship from the hiring district.
3. Apply and pay for the probationary certificate (www.tea.state.tx.us).
4. Complete a criminal background check and fingerprinting.
5. Complete 30 observation hours or substitute teaching hours in a state accredited school.

To be recommended for a standard certificate, a candidate must:

- 1. Complete all G-EPP requirements (including a year-long internship or semester-long student teaching).
2. Pass and submit scores for the TExES Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities test.
3. For candidates who have completed an internship: Provide the Certification Office with an official teacher service record from the district human resources office.
4. Apply and pay for the standard certificate (www.tea.state.tx.us)
