I work as a single nurse with two medical assistants and two Urgent Care providers. Census of an average day in summer ranges from 10-30. Census of an average day during flu and RSV season ranges from 25-50 patients a day. I Have a dual position at Shannon Medical Center where I am granted hours to properly chair the Clinic Shared Governance Committee and co-chair the Hospital Shared Governance Committee. These Committees are of 30 plus nursing staff members and work towards patient Safety, protocol reviews, and nurse morale. Responsibilities include hosting a monthly meeting</p>
