First meeting of this committee

The date for our visit from NCATE has been set on Nov. 25-27, 2012. We have this academic year to collect, report, and analyze program and disposition data. The NCATE report will be due next spring - 6 months before the visit.

Standard 1 was reviewed in a PowerPoint along with AFIs to address.

The NCATE web on the College of Education website was also shown with links to data and resources.

The Conceptual Framework is still under revision but will be distributed as soon as the final version is available. This is the basis for all our programs preparing teachers and other school professionals in the unit, including initial certification and advanced program levels.

Each exhibit in the Standard 1 list was discussed. Wendy Storms does the data entry for state and Title II. Chris Purkiss has worked hard with her committee to get the dispositions revised and data collection points established. Final copies of the dispositions and chart with data collection points will be sent by email to the committee members after this meeting. Data collection will begin during the current semester.

Wendy will also be accepting and posting data collected from programs across the unit. David Tarver's Assessment Committee compiled a chart of 6-8 assessments for each program which needs to be finalized at this time. If undergraduate programs needs an extra assessment, Chris suggested the Case Study done in EPSY 3303.

Wendy had discussed with the dean about collecting data from all programs for the electronic exhibit room for our visit. He suggested a meeting of program managers to follow up on individual conferences done by Dr. Tarver and Dr. Eisenwine over the summer. We can tell them at that time if they need to use the Case Study data for secondary programs, or any data Amy has collected in her courses. She already collects Assessment #3, evidence of planning, for the secondary candidates.
