Planning and Prioritizing

The committee will:

- Establish standards by which online or hybrid courses will be created or reviewed
- Provide oversight for ranking software or hardware and emerging technology for instructional purposes
- Develop a system for evaluating and assessing instructional technology services
- Identify current and emerging issues involving instructional technology
- Establish instructional technology plans, priorities and budgetary considerations for the college

Liaison Work

Departmental representatives will:

- Identify departmental technology needs, including energy efficient technology
- Improve communication within the college so that faculty have information regarding computer lab and software availability and access
- Make recommendations to Information Technology about campus technology

Training and Development

Departmental representatives will:

- Identify faculty to participate in peer learning
- Learn about upcoming IT updates
- Make recommendations related to instructional technology training and development, including:
 - Learning Management System proficiency
 - ADA compliance
 - Mobile learning
 - Universal design (digital content that is not restricted by a learner's device or proficiency with technology)
