Old Business:

2. Topic: EAB (D. Topliff)
 - D. Topliff informed members EAB representatives were on campus yesterday to get started on implementation of the Student Success Collaborative program. J. Wegner said the downloadable app will be started with new freshmen at NSO and will then be expanded to others. Once the app is downloaded the student will complete a survey that will then be used to push out customized information specific to that student.
3. Topic: SACS (D. Topliff)

4. Topic: Curriculum (D. Topliff)
 - D. Topliff said there is a UCC meeting tomorrow but we still haven't received the final decision on the core from the Coordinating Board yet. He said there will probably be another UCC meeting held in April.

5. Topic: Transfer Data (D. Topliff)
 - D. Topliff shared a spreadsheet of transfer data comparing Lone Star Conference and SACSCOC peers with ASU. The spreadsheet was sent by email to members earlier this morning. There was some discussion. D. Topliff informed members strategies to increase transfer students to ASU will be discussed at future meetings.

6. Topic: Faculty Salaries/Budget (D. Topliff)

- D. Topliff shared a spreadsheet of faculty salaries comparing fiscal year 17 and fiscal year 18. These numbers do not include the 1% raise given last January. He asked members to pay close attention to faculty salaries as they are working on the fiscal year 19 budget. D. Topliff said the workload move from 4x4 to 5x5 seems to have made a positive impact on the budget. He said the budget is being looked at with an eye towards raises in September.
